## Firelands Electric Cooperative Names General Manager

**NEW LONDON, November 20, 2017** — Firelands Electric Cooperative announced today that it has appointed Daniel McNaull of Ashland as general manager of the not-for-profit organization, effective upon the February 2, 2018, retirement of incumbent general manager April Bordas.

McNaull has served on the Firelands Electric Cooperative board since 1991, and was elected president in 1999. “Dan’s tenure on the Firelands board, coupled with his unparalleled business acumen, operational insight, and member service credentials, make him exceptionally qualified to assume effective responsibility of our co-op” said Bordas. “I fully endorse the board’s selection of Dan, with the confidence that our members, staff, and community partners are in capable hands.”

McNaull attended North Central Technical College and The Ohio State University, and is co-owner and vice president of Ashland Implement, Inc. He is a member of Ashland Dickey Church of the Brethren, where he serves in various capacities. McNaull is active with several committees of Farmers State Bank; is zoning commission chairman of Montgomery Township; and is the primary revisionist author of the township’s zoning regulations. Further, McNaull is a member of the Ashland Young Men’s Business Club, and is the nominating committee chairman of the Ohio Rural Electric Cooperatives (OREC) board of directors, where he also serves on the marketing committee. McNaull is on the joint policy committee for Buckeye Power and OREC, and is a national parts advisory board member for Case International.
